A cable has been put across the closed section of the In-town trail in Bingham. The trail is well signed now with at least a half mile warning before hitting the closed section of the trail. Starting July 5th there will be weekend only use on a section of trail from Embden Rd. in Concord all the way to Pleasant Ridge due to logging operations, signs will be going up very soon. I was told this should last until the end of August. There is also some logging activity in Athens. As usual please yield to all equipment and trucks.
